FOUR STEPS TO SHARE YOUR FAITH WITH A FRIEND.

PRAY



Write down the name of someone you know who needs Jesus and then pray each day for him or her. Ask God to open their heart and give you opportunities to share His love with them.

SHARE



Spend time with your friend. Grab a cup of coffee or attend an event together. It can deepen your friendship and create an opportunity to talk about Christ. Begin to talk with your friend about attending the event with you.

BRING



Bring your friend to the event. If he or she responds to Christ or begins to show interest in the Gospel, they will need your ongoing encouragement. (And if they don't respond, continue to love and pray for them.)

FOLLOW UP



Invite them to church with you. God can use you and your church to bring them into a deepening relationship with Jesus.

Day 1 - Saturday, September 7

KEY VERSE: "... the prayer of the upright is His delight."
(Proverbs 15:8, NKJV)

PRAYER POINT: The prayer of the believer who has aligned his life with the purposes of God and devotion to God, delights the very heart of God.

PRAYER: Dear Lord Jesus Christ, I align my heart and purposes with Yours. You love the world with all of its inhabitants and are not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance. May things shift in the invisible realm to bring conviction that leads to repentance and conversion. Let it begin within the scope of my circle of influence and let it spread like a blanket of grace across my region, my province, and nation. May the kingdoms of this earth become the kingdoms of our Lord and Christ.

Day 2 - Sunday, September 8

KEY VERSE: “For freedom Christ has set us free; stand firm therefore, and do not submit again to a yoke of slavery.” (**Galatians 5:1, ESV**)

PRAYER POINT: Pray for those who suffer from the bondage of addictions.

PRAYER: Father, we pray that many who are in the bondage of addiction will come and hear the message of hope at the Celebration weekend. We ask that they will find lasting freedom in Christ! May You give them strength to withstand every temptation, and may Your Holy Spirit transform them by the power of the Gospel as it is preached that day. We pray that they will know the joy of serving You and that they, in turn, will be used to bring others who struggle with addiction into Your freedom.

Day 3 - Monday, September 9

KEY VERSE: “I assure you: Whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers of Mine, you did for Me.”
(Matthew 25:40, HCSB)

PRAYER POINT: Pray that we will see Jesus in the faces of those who do not know Him. Pray that God will help us to support and love them more intentionally and invite them to Jesus.

PRAYER: Jesus, many people we see each day do not know Your love and hope. We ask that You would give us a passion, concern, and sympathy for them. We pray for creative ideas to help us to form relationships with them. Jesus, it is Your will that none should perish. We pray, Holy Spirit, that You would give us boldness and enthusiasm to share the Gospel. Help us to be Your hands and feet extended. Gracious God, help us to invite many to the Celebration of Hope that they might receive Your salvation for their lives.

Day 4 - Tuesday, September 10

KEY VERSE: “Whoever loves his brother abides in the light, and in him there is no cause for stumbling.”
(1 John 2:10, ESV)

PRAYER POINT: Pray that our hearts might be free of judgment and anger towards others so that we can radiate Jesus’ true light.

PRAYER: Lord, we repent of the sin of harboring the darkness of hatred, anger, and judgment against others. This blocks Your Light from shining through us and causes us to stumble and misrepresent You. We are sorry. Forgive us Father and wash us clean with the blood of Jesus to enable us to truly radiate Your Light. Help us to love others freely and openly and let there be no resistance in our expression of You.

Day 5 - Wednesday, September 11

KEY VERSE: “On hearing this, Jesus said, ‘It is not the healthy who need a doctor, but the sick. But go and learn what this means: ‘I desire mercy, not sacrifice.’ For I have not come to call the righteous, but sinners.’”
(Matthew 9:12-13, NIV)

PRAYER POINT: Let us repent on behalf of the church, for thinking that we are better than the “sinners.”

PRAYER: Father, forgive us for thinking we are better than those who are perishing. Give us Your heart for the lost, dying, and broken. Father, we cry out for mercy over the lives of those who do not know You. Just as You called us to salvation, we pray that You would call others in our region to come to You. Thank You for this in Jesus’ Name.

Day 6 - Thursday, September 12

KEY VERSE: “That ye may with one mind and one mouth glorify God, even the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ.” (Romans 15:6, KJV)

PRAYER POINT: That the ongoing unity amongst the churches in our region will increase and deepen.

PRAYER: Heavenly Father, we pray for the unity of Your church. We pray for the ongoing unity among the churches and for its increase and deepening. We pray for church leaders who are always on the frontline to walk closer to the Lord. We ask for their refreshing, emboldening, strengthening, protection, and encouragement. We pray for more servant-hearted leaders, for good role models, for faithful laborers. This we ask, that there may be revival in Your church and a harvest of souls in Jesus' Name.

Day 7 - Friday, September 13

KEY VERSE: “For the ways of man are before the eyes of the Lord, and He ponders all his paths. His own iniquities entrap the wicked man, and he is caught in the cords of his sin.” (Proverbs 5:21-22, NKJV)

PRAYER POINT: Pray that people will understand that sin separates us from Father God. Ask God that many will sense their need for forgiveness of their sins.

PRAYER: Gracious Father, all have sinned and fallen short of the glory of God. Many do not realize that sin separates us from You. Jesus, You died for forgiveness of our sins so that no one should perish. We pray, Holy Spirit, that You will convict us of our need for a Savior. We pray that many people will come to repentance at the Celebration of Hope. We pray they will experience Your love and restoration.

Day 8 - Saturday, September 14

KEY VERSE: “Elisha said, ‘Go around and ask all your neighbors for empty jars. Don’t ask for just a few. Pour oil into all the jars’ ... They brought the jars to her and she kept pouring. When all the jars were full, she said to her son, ‘Bring me another one’. But he replied, ‘There is not a jar left.’ Then the oil stopped flowing.” (2 Kings 4:3-6, NIV)

PRAYER POINT: God will pour the oil of His Spirit into as many as are willing to receive it. We need to be asking all our neighbors to the Celebration of Hope weekend.

PRAYER: Out of our deep spiritual need in the Quinte region, we come to You, Lord God, and ask for not a few, but many, to be filled with the life-giving oil of Your Spirit. As You take the spiritual poverty of our unsaved family and friends and turn it into untold kingdom riches, may that be the catalyst for revival amongst the churches in the Quinte region. Lord, grant us the capacity to truly believe in the transforming power of the Gospel and the courage to invite the “empty jars” in our sphere of influence who are waiting to be asked ... and filled.

Day 9 - Sunday, September 15

KEY VERSE: “Father I want those you have given me to be with me where I am, and to see my glory ... ”
(John 17:24, NIV)

PRAYER POINT: We can only present Jesus in all His glory if we have a fresh experience of Him for ourselves. This prayer seeks an empowering renewal within us.

PRAYER: O Lord, as we come in prayer to You, we think of the night You prayed for us. You prayed that we might be with You where You are and see Your glory and then You went to the cross to make it possible. So Lord, we come before You in submission and in awe. Revive us with a fresh sense of Your glory and a deep desire to see it manifest across our region and our country. Giver of all life, let Your life be the reality of our beings and the source of all power working through us for the salvation of souls. Draw us to abide in You and become branches that produce fruit as we abide in the one true vine. Equip and empower all of those working for the Celebration of Hope to be instruments of Your saving truth. May those attending the Celebration know that they are in the midst of a people who have been with Jesus! Revive us, O Lord, and revive our region for the glory of Your Name. This we humbly ask in Jesus’ Name.

Day 10 - Monday, September 16

KEY VERSE: “The King will reply, ‘Truly I tell you, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did for me.’” (**Matthew 25:40, NIV**)

PRAYER POINT: That we might see Jesus in the people around us—especially those who are desperate, under-resourced, and alone.

PRAYER: Lord of heaven—You appear in surprising places. You meet us in unlikely people. You consistently stretch us in our capacity to know You and You extend the horizons of how we expect to experience You. We ask that You give us courage to release the categories of convenience we hold—categories that can keep us from maturing, that can keep us from listening to Your voice, that can keep us from seeing You. Instead, help us to meet You in the faces of friends and strangers. Give us courage to share our lives with those who are in pain, so that we might discover Your presence there. Open our eyes as You disclose Your nearness and help us see how wonderfully close to us You are.

Day 11 - Tuesday, September 17

KEY VERSE: “Restore us, O God; let your face shine, that we may be saved.” (Psalm 80:3, NRSV)

PRAYER POINT: Pray for God to restore broken lives.

PRAYER: Father, only You can restore the human soul. We pray for those living in conditions of great brokenness, despair, frustration, and sadness. We pray this verse on their behalf. Restore them to wholeness, we pray. May they cry out to You to be saved and may they hunger and thirst for You alone. We pray that they would seek You with all their hearts. May those who are searching find their way to the Celebration of Hope weekend. May Your face shine upon them and may their lives be restored to You.

Amen.

Day 12 - Wednesday, September 18

KEY VERSE: “If my people, who are called by my name, humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and I will forgive their sin and heal their land.”

(2 Chronicles 7:14, NIV)

PRAYER POINT: That Christians would rise in humility and repentant prayer for sin in their region.

PRAYER: Lord, we truly seek Your face and pray on behalf of Your sons and daughters in this region that You would forgive our sins. We turn away from our wicked ways of unbelief, pride, and selfishness, which have blocked our intimacy with You. Lord, we pray the blood of Jesus over these sins, and thank You that You forgive us. We ask You to break the bondage of sin off our land and any attached curses from the enemy. Lord, we rejoice that You will heal our land! Take us back into Your heart; heal Your children and may we hear from Heaven, we pray.

Day 13 - Thursday, September 19

KEY VERSE: “Those who go out weeping, bearing the seed for sowing, shall come home with shouts of joy, carrying their sheaves.” (**Psalm 126:6, NRSV**)

PRAYER POINT: That the burden of prayer and the hard work of preparation will result in the joy of a great harvest at the Celebration Of Hope weekend.

PRAYER: Father, we thank You that You are restoring the fortunes of the church in the Quinte region. And we have so much to praise You for already—the Lord has done great things for us and we are glad! We thank You that Will Graham and the team will come to us in the fullness of the blessing of Christ and that there will soon be a wonderful harvest of people coming to know You for the first time. May the multitude that watch online from many nations also believe the Gospel and be saved. May even the news media acknowledge that the Lord did a great thing in CAA Arena. Then our mouths will be filled with laughter, and our tongues with shouts of joy!

Day 14 - Friday, September 20

KEY VERSE: “The Lord is not slack concerning His promise, as some count slackness, but is longsuffering toward us, not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance.” (2 Peter 3:9, NKJV)

PRAYER POINT: Lord, may a great number from our region come to repentance and be saved from an eternal death.

PRAYER: Heavenly Father, we come to You in the Name of Jesus with the full assurance that Your eyes are upon our region and that You are not willing that any should perish in eternity. We ask, O Lord, that You would awaken in the church a passionate conviction to reach the lost at any cost. Father, we pray that the glorious light of the Gospel would shine brightly through Your church in our region without any hindrance. We pray that thousands of people will make a decision to follow Christ when the invitation is given by Will Graham at the Celebration of Hope weekend. We pray that our region will be impacted as thousands of new believers will be added to the church. We believe that now is the time for the kingdom of God to invade the Quinte region in an unprecedented way and so we thank You Lord that Your Name will be exalted in every sphere and sector of our region in Jesus' Name.

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Day 15 - Saturday, September 21

KEY VERSE: “With all lowliness and gentleness, with longsuffering, bearing with one another in love, endeavoring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.” (**Ephesians 4:2-3, NKJV**)

PRAYER POINT: May we intentionally reach out to other Christians to foster unity in the Body of Christ.

PRAYER: Lord, we pray that we might see through spiritual eyes what Your Kingdom looks like from Heaven’s perspective. We ask for wisdom and discernment to perceive the new things You are doing in our midst. We see that You are joining a variety of Christian churches in unity through prayer gatherings in preparation for the Celebration of Hope weekend. It’s such a privilege to work together to share the hope of the Gospel of Jesus Christ to a world that so desperately needs it. And like Joseph’s coat of many colors, the diversity in our unity displays the beauty and uniqueness we all offer. Lord, bless us with an increase of Your love for each other, and a zeal for You and Your plans.

Day 16 - Sunday, September 22

KEY VERSE: “For he himself is our peace, who has made the two groups one and has destroyed the barrier, the dividing wall of hostility.” **(Ephesians 2:14, NIV)**

PRAYER POINT: Pray for the healing of relationships to begin to flow; let all be reconciled first to God through the provision of the cross and then reconciled with each other in families, in communities, and among different sectors in the body of Christ.

PRAYER: Father, You have extended to us the gift of peace and brought us back to Yourself. May we understand and experience the depth and breadth of Your peace to bring back together those who have been separated from each other. Let forgiveness penetrate all barriers and break down every wall of hostility in relationships in families, in communities, and among believers. May you release the grace, mercy, and patience into our places of brokenness. You have received us with Your great redeeming love. Let that same love now flow to heal the wounds and restore us to one another.

Day 17 - Monday, September 23

KEY VERSE: “Let the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be acceptable in your sight, O Lord, my rock and my redeemer.” (**Psalm 19:14, ESV**)

PRAYER POINT: We are responsible for the words we speak, and the thoughts that are prevalent in our hearts. God sees and knows everything. He is our Father, our strength, and our deliverer.

PRAYER: Dear Lord, prepare each of us as Christians, to examine our hearts and the words we speak. Help us to be worthy ambassadors for You as we reach out to others. Lord, humble us to walk in Your ways and to reflect the love You have for all humanity. Help us to honor You by taking our thoughts, words, and deeds captive to Your will; enable us to discard those that dishonor You and replace them with life, love, faith, and grace. Cleanse us and forgive us for anything that would stand in the way of salvation for those who do not know You. We long to please You, Lord, for all You have sacrificed for us on the cross. Grant us Your empowering presence to have harmony of heart, and may the words we speak be for Your sake.

Day 18 - Tuesday, September 24

KEY VERSE: “I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life.” (John 8:12, NIV)

PRAYER POINT: That God’s people would live as light in a dark world.

PRAYER: Lord Jesus, Your Word says that we “are now light in the Lord,” and You command that we must “Live as children of light” (Ephesians 5:8, NIV). We ask that our lives would be full light, and that goodness, righteousness, and truth would be evident in our lives. We lament the characteristics of our age that give darkness a foothold. We ask that You enable us to influence our culture in Your Name. Let us to be light in the world and glorify You through our lives.

Day 19 - Wednesday, September 25

KEY VERSE: “Be alert and of sober mind. Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour.” (1 Peter 5:8, NIV)

PRAYER POINT: Pray that God’s people would walk in the victory Jesus has won for them on the cross. Ask God to help us rely on Jesus’ strength and not our own.

PRAYER: Loving Father, thank You for what Jesus accomplished for us on the cross. Jesus, You defeated our enemy Satan. We pray that people will call on Your Name. For we can do all things through Christ who strengthens us. We pray You would make Your Word alive in our hearts. Holy Spirit, we ask that You open our spiritual eyes and ears to hear Your voice speak to us through the Word. We ask that You would make Your Word a lamp to our feet and a light to our path.

Day 20 - Thursday, September 26

KEY VERSE: “To them God has chosen to make known among the Gentiles the glorious riches of this mystery, which is Christ in you, the hope of glory.”

(Colossians 1:27, NIV)

PRAYER POINT: Pray for a strong move of God’s presence among the unbelievers.

PRAYER: Lord Jesus, we know that You are coming back soon. We pray that Your great grace will be poured out as we work together in unity to gather the harvest. Father, we thank You that You have chosen us to make known Your glorious riches of Christ to unbelievers. We pray that blinders will be removed from the eyes of those who are perishing, so that they may see the light of the Gospel and come into salvation!

Day 21 - Friday, September 27

KEY VERSE: “What a person desires is unfailing love ... The Lord is gracious and compassionate, slow to anger and rich in love.” (**Proverbs 19:22 & Psalm 145:8, NIV**)

PRAYER POINT: That the love of God will be experienced by those who are lost.

PRAYER: Father, we thank You that You are slow to anger and rich in unfailing love. Father, we ask that You continue to pour out Your mercy over the lives of those in our region who do not know You. We pray that many will have encounters with You that will convince them of Your love for them. May Your love reach the core of who You’ve created them to be, and may they come into their God-ordained destiny. We thank You for divine love encounters throughout this region.

Amen.

Day 22 - Saturday, September 28

KEY VERSE: “The Lord our God is merciful and forgiving, even though we have rebelled against Him.”
(Daniel 9:9, NLT)

PRAYER POINT: That God’s nature as the merciful and forgiving One will be made known all across this region. Pray that many will draw close to our heavenly Father whose heart is to receive mankind and love us with a love we have never really known.

PRAYER: Father, we know it is in Your heart to have Your true nature revealed to a hurting and lost humanity. We pray that through the continued prayers and the courage of Your people to share the Gospel, many will come into a relationship with the One who loves them and yearns for them even though they have turned their backs on Him. We pray that hearts will be open to receive a love that is so pure and deep that a relationship can be born and a journey begun.

Day 23 - Sunday, September 29

KEY VERSE: “This hope we have as an anchor of the soul, both sure and steadfast.” (**Hebrews 6:19, NKJV**)

PRAYER POINT: That the message of hope will be received by those who have lost their way due to the entanglements of sin and confusions of life.

PRAYER: Holy Spirit, we pray that You will continue to hover over the Quinte region as you prepare the hearts of people to receive the message of hope that will be preached in the coming days. We pray for those who are in hopeless situations, especially those who are contemplating suicide right now. May they know that Jesus came to give them life and show them the way to a loving heavenly Father. We pray for those struggling with terminal diseases asking, “why?” May they find hope and healing. We pray for families with broken relationships. May you help them find reconciliation and unity in You. Lord, may your hope find its way to everyone who comes to the Celebration of Hope.

Day 24 - Monday, September 30

KEY VERSE: “The Spirit of the Lord will rest on him—the Spirit of wisdom and of understanding, the Spirit of counsel and of might, the Spirit of the knowledge and fear of the Lord.” (Isaiah 11:2, NIV)

PRAYER POINT: That the Spirit of Christ would empower His church in our region.

PRAYER: Father in heaven and Lord of the church, we come before You in reverence of Your pure and priceless presence that fills the earth as the waters cover the sea. We honor and worship You as the head of your church around the world, and we thank You for the gift of Your Spirit that fills the body of Christ in the Quinte region. Your Spirit of wisdom and understanding fills us with compassion and understanding. Your Spirit of counsel and might gives us strength in weakness. May the Spirit of the knowledge and fear of the Lord renew us, embolden us, and sustain us.

Day 25 - Tuesday, October 1

KEY VERSE: “You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit and that your fruit should abide, so that whatever you ask the Father in my name, he may give it to you.” (**John 15:16, ESV**)

PRAYER POINT: That Christians in the Quinte region might understand that they have been chosen and anointed by Jesus for such a time as this.

PRAYER: Father God, we ask that Your Holy Spirit would speak to Your thousands of followers in this Quinte region and inspire them with our privilege and responsibility, as ambassadors of Your kingdom, in the ministry of reconciliation. Thank You for not only choosing us, but also anointing us with supernatural power and authority to lead our friends and families, through Jesus, toward Your kingdom. We ask in Jesus’ Name for opportunities and boldness to invite those within our circles to be at the Celebration of Hope weekend, and to be open to the drawing of Your Spirit.

Day 26 - Wednesday, October 2

KEY VERSE: “Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved—you and your household.” (Acts 16:31, NIV)

“But as for me and my household, we will serve the Lord.” (Joshua 24:15, NIV)

PRAYER POINT: That salvation will be experienced not only by individuals, but by entire families.

PRAYER: Lord, we pray for household salvations. We ask that the message of Your salvation will come in power to families that have been ravaged by unfaithfulness, misunderstanding, and other forms of brokenness. We pray that salvation will bring reconciliation, unity, and faithfulness in homes everywhere. We ask for entire households to be saved, and that they will be able to serve You as a family for generations to come.

Day 27 - Thursday, October 3

KEY VERSE: “As for what was sown on good soil, this is the one who hears the word and understands it. He indeed bears fruit and yields, in one case a hundredfold, in another sixty, and in another thirty.”
(Matthew 13:23, ESV)

PRAYER POINT: Pray for the Word of God that will be preached during the Celebration of Hope weekend, that it will produce a great harvest of souls.

PRAYER: Jesus, we ask that the Word of God will be convicting and refreshing for those who come to the Celebration of Hope weekend. We pray that You will prepare the hearts of people to receive the Word and that the message preached will fall on eager hearts. We pray that this seed will not be stolen by the evil one, but will take root in their lives and will grow to full maturity, bearing a hundredfold harvest for Your glory.

Day 28 - Friday, October 4
CELEBRATION—DAY 1

KEY VERSE: “The Lord is ... patient toward you, not wishing that any should perish, but that all should reach repentance.” (2 Peter 3:9, ESV)

PRAYER POINT: Pray that our hearts would be filled with faith, and that we may believe for all to be saved.

PRAYER: Father, we thank You for Your patience towards us. It is not Your desire that any should perish. Would You put that same desire in the hearts of the believers? We ask that no one who comes to the Celebration of Hope weekend will go back the same. Let every unbeliever come to repentance and receive new life at the event. We pray that You would stir our hearts to love the lost, and that the lost will be stirred with a desire to know You. May You be glorified through the many who will come to faith in Christ during the Celebration of Hope weekend. In Jesus' Name.

Day 29 - Saturday, October 5
CELEBRATION—DAY 2

KEY VERSE: “Whoever wants to be my disciple must deny themselves and take up their cross and follow me.”
(Mark 8:34, NIV)

PRAYER POINT: Pray that we will make it a priority in our life to fulfill Jesus’ Great Commission to us “to go forth and make disciples of all men.”

PRAYER: Jesus, our loving Savior, we pray that You would give us courage to step out of our comfort zone to share Your words of salvation with others. We ask that You would help us to conduct ourselves in a way that would draw others to You. We pray our families and friends would see Your love and the fruit of Your spirit in our actions. That a hunger for You would come into their hearts. We pray You will stir them to come out to the Celebration of Hope weekend and hear your words of life.

Day 30 - Sunday, October 6
CELEBRATION—DAY 3

KEY VERSE: “And it shall be that every living thing that moves, wherever the rivers go, will live. There will be a very great multitude of fish, because these waters go there; for they will be healed, and everything will live wherever the river goes.” **(Ezekiel 47:9, NKJV)**

PRAYER POINT: Ask that the Holy Spirit flow from believers so that rivers of life can touch the lives around us with His transforming power at work in us.

PRAYER: Jesus, You told us that rivers of living water shall flow from us, and we know that the same power that raised You from the dead lives in us. We ask You to make that a reality to us so that we would depend on You and call upon You in times of weakness. We trust Your power at work within us to help us and reach those we are praying for. You are the Author of life, Father, and we look to You. Show us what it means to live and move and have our being in You so we can know You and make You known and bring life wherever we go. Revive us, O Lord!
